10 reasons to choose Lausanne for your event

Easy access

As Switzerland's fourth-biggest city and capital of the Canton of Vaud, Lausanne enjoys a privileged geographical location at the centre of Europe. It is easily accessible by train, car, boat and aeroplane, being situated near Geneva International Airport (40 minutes) and Zurich Airport (2 hours 30 minutes).

Research and excellence

Lausanne is known for its internationally renowned institutions of higher education (University, Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne, IMD, Lausanne Hotel Management School, etc.) and centres of medical research, not to mention the presence of numerous multinationals. The region thus offers an ideal environment for the organisation of international conferences, medical conventions and business meetings.

Olympic Capital

The International Olympic Committee, the Olympic Museum and more than 40 international sports federations and organisations have chosen to be based in the Olympic Capital, the only title of its kind in the world. Arrival in Lausanne, centre of Europe

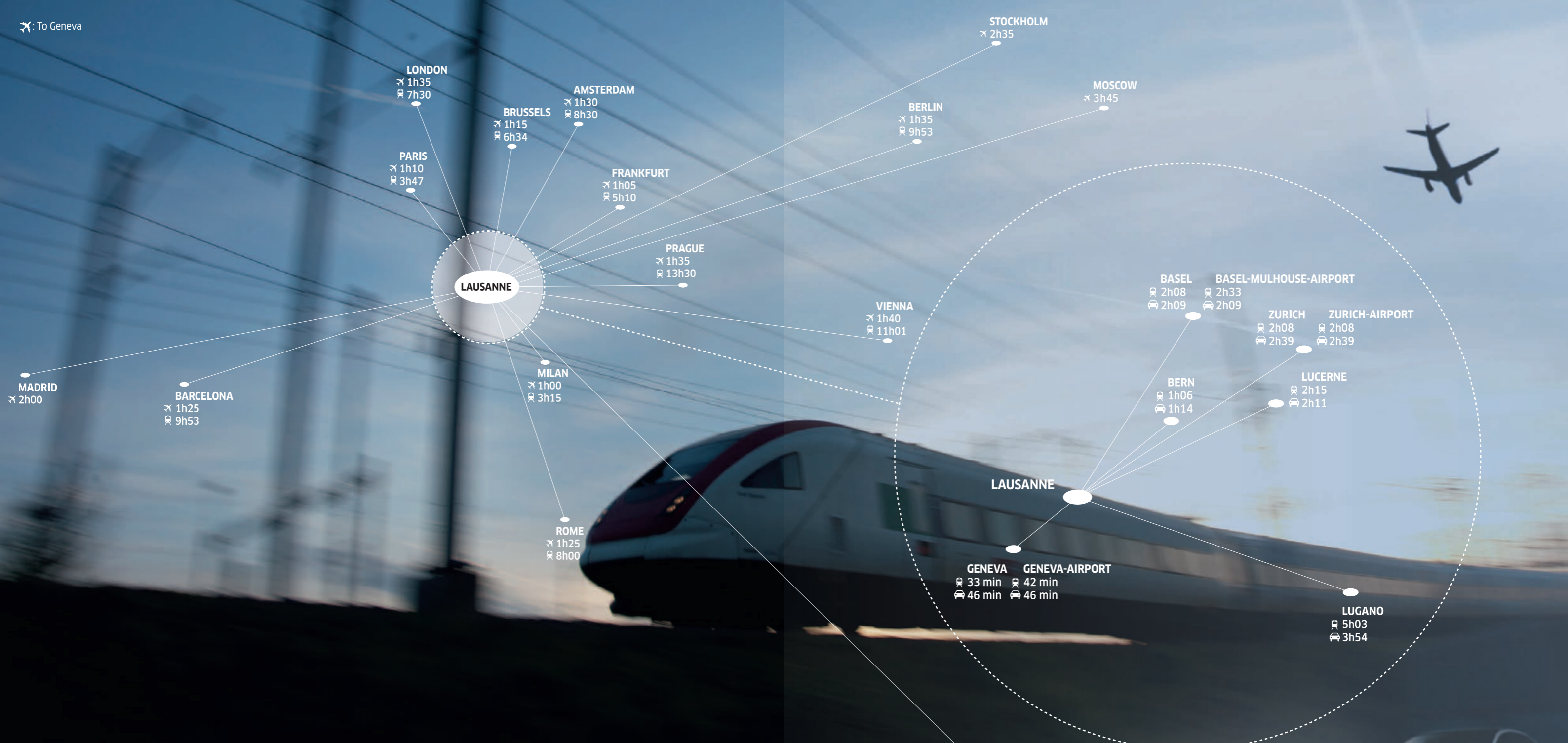

City Guide

Highlights of Lausanne

Sauvabelin Tower

Perched above the city, this 35-metre-high structure, built exclusively from recyclable materials, offers 360° panoramic views over the Lake Geneva basin, the Alps and the Jura. Free admission.

Lausanne city tour

Discover the highlights of the city, by coach or on foot: the old town with its magnificent 13th-century Gothic cathedral, its town hall and its picturesque market (Wednesday and Saturday mornings), the different districts, the Olympic sites, the universities and colleges, and the Roman ruins.

Lausanne city tour, vineyard or Olympic Museum option →

Visit the highlights of the city (see opposite). Optional extra: excursion through the Lavaux vineyard, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, including a break to sample the wines in a typical cellar, or a visit to the Olympic Museum, the world's largest information centre on the Olympic Movement and its ideals. The museum is undergoing refurbishment and will reopen in 2014.

Heritage

Romainmôtier and abbey

Visit the little market town and Clunisian site of Romainmôtier, situated in a wooded valley looking towards the Jura mountains. Its 11th-century abbey is a masterpiece of Swiss Romanesque art. Organ recital on request.

Gruyères

Perched at the top of a hill, the picturesque medieval town of Gruyères is dominated by a magnificent 12th-century castle (tour optional). Watch the cheese being made and sample the famous Gruyère Swiss cheese in an authentic alpine chalet. Possibility of combining this with a visit to the Maison Cailler chocolate factory (Nestlé).

Jura, watchmaking country

Switzerland is famous for its high-quality luxury watches. This excursion includes a visit to the Museum of Music Boxes, which has a unique collection of mechanical musical inventions. Explore the charming Jura region as far as La Chaux-de-Fonds, one of the main centres of the Swiss watchmaking industry, and visit the prestigious Watch Museum, an international point of reference when it comes to the history of measuring time.

Château de Chillon and Montreux →

A fortress on the side facing the mountain and a princely residence on the side facing the lake, this 12th-century castle is superbly situated on the banks of Lake Geneva. Guided tour of the château and a stop in Montreux on the return journey.

Gastronomy

Sévery oil mill

Built in 1845, Sévery Mill is one of the few traditional oil mills still in operation. Arrangements may be made for a tour, a tasting session, an aperitif or a meal on-site.

House of Wheat and Bread, Echallens

Depart from the LEB station in Lausanne and journey by train to Echallens, travelling through one of the biggest wheat-growing regions in Switzerland. Tour the House of Wheat and Bread (Maison du Blé et du Pain), recognised at European level. You may make a reservation to work your own dough and take home the *tresse* (plait) you make. Option of brunch on-site. Return to Lausanne by coach.

Museum of the Old Pays-d'Enhaut and Maison de l'Etivaz

For nearly a century, the Museum of the Old Pays-d'Enhaut has embodied the memory of a region long isolated in its mountain setting. Its inhabitants have crafted objects of exceptional quality that can be seen in several rooms reproducing the ambiance of the homes of yesteryear. Etivaz cheese is the first Swiss product to have been awarded an appellation of controlled origin (AOC). A visit to the cellars of the Maison de l'Etivaz is rounded off by an aperitif and a tasting session.

Lavaux Vinorama →

Educational and enjoyable at the same time, this centre is housed in an ultra-contemporary building and offers an area for the tasting, consumption and sale of wines from the Lavaux vineyard, a high-tech projection room showing a film in 8 languages, a meeting room for hire, tasting seminars and a small shop.



Nature

Bex salt mine

After an audiovisual presentation, a mini-train takes visitors to the heart of the mine, 400 m below ground. From here, an hour's walk provides an insight into extraction techniques used since 1684. Option of lunch in an unusual setting. Closed to visitors in January.

St-Léonard subterranean lake

Guided tour by rowing boat on the biggest natural and navigable subterranean lake in Europe (300 m long), nestled in the hillside between 30 and 70 metres below the vineyard. On request: break for coffee and croissants, aperitif, raclette, concerts and musical interludes at the heart of the cave. Not open to visitors in winter.

Interlaken and Jungfrauojoch

Travel by motorway to Interlaken. Free time in this famous holiday resort. From Interlaken, it is possible to go to the Jungfrauojoch, at an altitude of 3,454 m, on the highest railway in Europe. Unobstructed views of the north face of the Eiger, the Mönch, the Jungfrau and the Aletsch glacier.

Montreux and Rochers-de-Naye

Travel along the road by the lake to Montreux, then by rack railway up to Rochers-de-Naye. Spectacular views over Lake Geneva and the Swiss and French Alps. Stop in Montreux on the way back. Optional tour of Château de Chillon.

Leysin and the Le Kuklos revolving restaurant →

Take the motorway from Lausanne towards Aigle, then the mountain road. Arrive in Leysin, a summer and winter resort in the Vaudois Alps situated on a magnificent sun terrace. Journey by cable car up the Berneuse. Spectacular panoramic views from the "Le Kuklos" revolving restaurant at an altitude of 2,048 m.

Zermatt - Matterhorn

An unforgettable day at the foot of the spectacular Matterhorn. In the morning, travel by coach to Täsch in the canton of Valais. Journey by rack railway to Zermatt, a car-free resort. Optional excursion to the Gornergrat: at an altitude of 3,000 m, this magnificent plateau offers incomparable views of 36 summits at an altitude of over 4,000 m.



Transport

La Galère

Named La Liberté, this galley for the third millennium was created thanks to the expertise and passion of the people of today inspired by the traditions of yesteryear. Arrangements may be made for individual cruises, themed cruises, parties and timeless receptions with onboard meals. (max 120 person)

Les Aquarels du Léman (solar-powered boats)

Discover the shores of Lake Geneva in a solar-powered boat, the best way of reconciling relaxation and sustainable development. Three ships can sail from Lausanne or any other port of embarkation in the surrounding area. An aperitif or a meal can be served on board (from June to mid-September). (max 24 person)

CGN boat cruises →

Enjoy an unforgettable cruise on Lake Geneva aboard a Belle Epoque ship as you discover ports, castles, vineyards and the snow-covered peaks of the Swiss and French Alps. Onboard catering.

LEB train

The Green Line of the LEB railway will take you across the Gros-de-Vaud region. An electric railcar dating back to 1947 has been converted into the restaurant train (TrainResto). This may be combined with the retro Zi5 buffet car on request. (max 32 person)

Chocolate train

Travel from Montreux in authentic luxury Belle Epoque carriages and/or in a modern panoramic coach, exclusively in first class. Visit the Château de Gruyères, sample the famous Gruyère cheese as you watch it being made and try some traditional Swiss chocolate in the Maison Cailler (Nestlé) factory. From May to October.

GoldenPass →

After travelling by coach to Montreux by Lake Geneva, you will experience an unforgettable ride on the Belle Epoque "GoldenPass Panoramic" train to Gstaad, via Château-d'Oex and Saanen. Free time in the world-famous resort of Gstaad: tour, shopping and lunch (optional). Return to Lausanne by coach.



Group activities all year round

Groups and organisers of group activities (incentive programmes) can choose from a vast range of sports and recreational programmes that help to promote group bonding and interaction between its members. Take up the challenge in summer and winter alike, with original team games led by experienced guides. Some of these activities are restricted to small groups for technical reasons. Others are only feasible at certain times of the year, depending on the weather conditions. Most of these activities are organised by our local service providers.

Food-related activity

Alimentarium

In the heart of the old town of Vevey beside Lake Geneva, the Alimentarium is the only museum in the world devoted exclusively to the human diet. You will have the opportunity to take part in interactive cookery workshops to test your senses and learn the different ways in which meals have been prepared down the centuries in various cultures. The café-restaurant can be hired for cocktails.

Themed wine tasting

A vintner will introduce you to a range of wines from a wine-producing estate and pair them with other local products or tasty morsels in the form of an informal workshop. Pairings are possible with chocolate, cheese, tapas, sushi, risotto, sorbets and a variety of gourmet delights.

Treasure hunt in Lavaux

This orienteering competition takes you among the vines to search for clues that will help you to discover the secret location where an aperitif of the local wines will be served.

Cooking classes

Different service providers and restaurants offer you an opportunity to participate in cookery workshops, which generally involve producing a full menu with several recipes. Menu themes vary depending on the season and the event organisers.

Wine casino

The Route du Vignoble (vineyard route) offers you a unique, lively and prestigious evening that allows you to play on real casino tables turned into gaming and tasting tables. To round off the event, you participate in a fictional auction and use the tokens you have won to buy a number of lots put together by your host vintner.

Competition on the art of winemaking

Set in the winemaker's museum in the La Côte vineyard, you will take part in a fun competition in which you have to identify all sorts of tools and objects related to the cultivation of vines and wine production. Prizes awarded to the 3 winners.

Chocolate workshop →

A demonstration of the traditional art of chocolate making in a laboratory and tasting of cocoa from a variety of sources. Making their own chocolates will enable participants to learn about the different techniques used to create chocolate moulds and pralines.

The "Route du Vignoble" (vineyard route) rally

Working in teams, participants discover the region and solve riddles off the beaten path in a wine-themed treasure hunt. It is possible to live up the "produits du terroir" (local products) clues with different clues of a more sporty nature, or to organise a gourmet walk during which the meal is eaten at the different stages of the event.



Teambuilding

"SEWA Beats" percussionists

Percussion instruments are increasingly being used to enliven conferences, personnel development courses and team-building exercises. Inhibitions melt away as participants allow themselves to be carried away by the music to create a collective synergy.

Vini Challenge

Held in the form of a competition, these mini-Olympics combine several activities requiring agility and concentration on the subject of winemaking.

Lausanne Safari

This treasure hunt gives teams the opportunity to enjoy an unusual walk discovering the treasures of Lausanne. Riddles are used as an appealing and original approach to subjects including history, architecture, art, prominent people with links to the region, customs, the art of living, gastronomy and unusual features. The programme concludes with the preparation and presentation of exploration notebooks in which the participants report on what impressed them and what they experienced together. Option of refreshments or gourmet break.

Olympics of the 5 senses →

The programme is a "trendy" stroll from workshop to workshop as we rediscover our 5 senses. Divided into teams, the participants have to identify original smells, aromas, materials and brief and varied sounds without falling into the trap of visual illusions.

City discovery

Fun and educational treasure hunts organised in teams will allow you to discover various aspects of Lausanne: animals, history, sustainable development, sport, arts and sciences, etc.



Theme park

Parc Aventure

In a parkland setting, the different sites of Parc Aventure are particularly suitable for group outings. Equipped with a safety harness, you will swing through the trees in absolute safety. Various challenges provide an exciting experience for participants. It is possible to eat on-site. Open from April to October.

FunPlanet

The only one of its kind in Switzerland, this indoor 10,000 m² complex situated at the end of Lake Geneva in the direction of Valais offers you a multitude of activities: bowling, karting, billiards and video games as well as Switzerland's first Race Café (simulators) and Golfy (mini-golf).

Labyrinth Adventure

This is the biggest permanent maze in the world. Having found your way through 18,000 thuja trees along a route measuring 3 km, why not let yourself be swept away by a giant slide more than 30 m high? Various attractions such as a climbing wall, tunnel, treasure hunt and orienteering competition make this expedition the ideal outing for groups and incentive trips. Open from March to November.

Aquaparc →

Open all year round, this water park is a truly tropical oasis beside Lake Geneva. Over 1,000 m of slides converge in the pools, which are heated to 29 °C. In summer, the park provides special access to a sandy beach, the only one on the shores of Lake Geneva.



Sport

Introduction to sailing and regatta

Team members are given a brief explanation of how a sailing boat works and what happens in a regatta. Once on board the boats, each team member will take part in the manoeuvres on the orders of a professional skipper. This is an activity in which each person assumes responsibility and interacts with teammates to attain a common goal.

Paragliding

Treat yourself to a flight in a two-seater paraglider on the Riviera and Lake Geneva. Fully qualified professional pilots will enable you to experience the pleasure of flying in complete peace and safety.

Activities on Glacier 3000

Not only during the winter, but also during the summer, Glacier 3000 offers a large variety of activities in a spectacular setting of the eternal snow. Besides hiking and skiing, the experience of the unique snow bus taking you on a ride over the glacier and a dog sled ride can be organized, also as teambuilding experience. The more adventurous may have a ride on the Alpine Coaster - the world's highest bobsleigh track.

Water sports ↓

Several group activities are organised on various bodies of water. River rafting is a feasible option for anyone, whilst wakeboarding and water skiing on Lake Geneva make for an invigorating outing!

Raft building

Beside a stretch of water, the teams must organise themselves to take on a double timed challenge: construct a raft from limited resources in the fastest possible time, then board the raft as a full team and row along a marked route as quickly as possible. The activity is accompanied by a guide and a rescue boat.

Introduction to track cycling or BMX

The World Cycling Centre caters not only for the world of sport, but also for companies, associations, clubs and organisations seeking an original and unique venue in which to combine work, sport or recreational activities, introductions, cocktails, meals, guided tours and teambuilding exercises. This is an opportunity to discover track cycling or BMX under the guidance of qualified instructors and in the company of champions.

Golf ↓

The Lake Geneva region has four golf courses that are easily accessible from Lausanne. Imagine a course in a dream setting with views of the Alps and Lake Geneva. As you follow the trajectory of the little white ball, your gaze will be lost in breathtaking scenery.

Dragon Boat

In this type of boat, which is of Chinese origin, the paddlers sit side by side in pairs and face the direction of travel. At the front of the boat, the drummer beats the drum to set the pace. The helmsman, in the rear, keeps the team on course. The teams must cover a short distance several times.

Introduction to curling

Learn how to play this traditional team game under the watchful eye of an expert. To succeed, you need to be smart and have some technical understanding of the sport and, above all, a sense of fair play and good team spirit.

Skis, luge and snowshoes ↓

There are 100 km of ski slopes with access to three valleys and a glacier in the Villars area. Torch-lit descents can be arranged. Other winter activities can be enjoyed here, including snowshoe walks with or without a guide and a downhill ride of over 7 km on a luge (also available at night after sharing a fondue).



Other activities

Cultural, technical and professional visits can also be arranged in various museums, schools and industries.
