



A warm welcome to the Jungfrau Region – in the heart of Switzerland


During your stay in the Jungfrau Region you'll be greeted by a mountain world with eternally white summits. The icy trio of the Eiger, Mönch & Jungfrau seems almost close enough to touch. Interlaken – the gateway to the Jungfrau – nestles between two crystal-clear lakes. A hiking paradise and chalet villages await you in Wengen and Grindelwald. Whether your taste is for Swiss tradition with alphorn players or a racy downhill ride with one of the new mountain carts: the excursion mountains of the Jungfrau Region are full of attractions for adventure freaks, hiking fans and those simply seeking peace and quiet. In winter, the Jungfrau Region offers over 200 kilometres of pistes as well as a wide variety of sledge runs and winter-walking paths. And while freestylers practice their jumps in the halfpipe on Grindelwald-First, skiers can test their skills on the famous Lauberhorn downhill piste.

The highlight of every visit to Switzerland is the trip to the Jungfraujoch –Top of Europe, Europe's highest-altitude railway station. The Jungfrau Railway is one of the world's most impressive feats of railway construction. The cogwheel railway has been travelling from Kleine Scheidegg through a seven-kilometre – long tunnel hewn through the rock of the Eiger and Mönch since 1912. After climbing 1400 metres in height, the Jungfrau Railway reaches its goal, the Jungfraujoch at 3454 metres above sea level, open 365 days a year. Visitors arrive in the UNESCO World Heritage Jungfrau-Aletsch, a world of eternal ice and snow. The Alpine Sensation round tour, Ice Palace, Sphinx vantage terrace, panorama restaurants and the Lindt Chocolate Shop, the highest of its kind in the world, guarantee a unique experience in sensational natural surroundings. The Jungfrau Region captivates visitors with its natural beauty and diversity, in summer as well as in winter. This is where you'll find the best of Switzerland in one place. We look forward to welcoming you and wish you an unforgettable stay.


The visit to the Jungfraujoch—Top of Europe is one of the most memorable experiences in every tour of Switzerland.

The construction of the Jungfrau Railway numbers among the most impressive achievements in railway technology. The brainchild of Zurich industrialist Adolf Guyer-Zeller, the railway was officially opened on 1 August 1912 after a building period of 16 years. It runs from Kleine Scheidegg through the Eiger to the Jungfraujoch—Top of Europe, Europe's highest-altitude railway station at 3454 metres above sea level.

Thanks to new and faster trains and only one intermediate stop in the tunnel, travelling time to the Jungfraujoch—Top of Europe has been reduced by approximately 15 minutes each way. In addition, the journey itself has become more flexible. As from 2016, trains to the Jungfraujoch—Top of Europe run every thirty minutes.



Jungfrau Eiger Walk from Eigergletscher to Kleine Scheidegg

The theme trail, which tells of the triumphs and tragedies on the Eiger North Wall, can be walked in one hour. The wide path from the Eigergletscher station down to Kleine Scheidegg can also be hiked uphill in the opposite direction. The trail passes the original hut in which mountaineers spent the night before beginning their ascent. The interactive, multimedia installation in the 'Kirchli' (a former transformer station, often said to resemble a small church) shows the ascents of the world-famous wall of rock. The boulders around the lake are memorials to the mountaineers who lost their lives on the Eiger.




Grindelwald – First Aerial Cableway

The six-seater aerial cableway on the sunny side of the Grindelwald Valley leads from the glacier village of Grindelwald to First at 2168 m above sea level. The wide variety of exciting attractions found in this excursion region include the First Flyer, which is unique in Europe, scooter-bike rides and several theme trails. Lake Bachalp is famous as the pearl of mountain lakes and a favourite hiking destination.





First Cliff Walk by Tissot

Free circular summit path with stunning views.

A spectacular circular trail awaits visitors at the First top station. The path has a cliff-side walkway, a hanging bridge and a vantage platform at a dizzying height with stunning views towards the Eiger. The trail is suitable for all ages and guarantees thrills galore.



Mountain cart

Steer down the unsurfaced three-kilometre track. The new fun-sport buggy with a comfy seat, good tyres and solid brakes takes you safely down the unsurfaced track from Schreckfeld to Bort. The mountain cart, a combination of go-kart and toboggan is also suitable for children, minimum height 135 cm. Safety helmets are provided free of charge.

Schynige Platte Railway (Wilderswil – Schynige Platte)

Opened in 1893, the nostalgic cogwheel railway carries visitors up to breathtaking mountain scenery and a popular hiking region with unparalleled views of the Eiger, Mönch & Jungfrau. The railway's lovingly maintained historic locomotives and carriages make the 50-minute journey itself a wonderful experience for people of all ages. Steam train trips can be arranged for groups on request. Located at 1967 metres above sea level, you'll find a mountain hotel and the Botanical Alpine Garden with 650 different species of plants.

The Lauterbrunnen – Mürren Rail & Cableway provides access to the car-free village of Mürren and consists of two sections: the first 685 metres of altitude from Lauterbrunnen to Grütschalp are mastered by aerial cableway. At Grütschalp, passengers change to a panorama railway which carries them across Alpine pastures via Winteregg to Mürren.
